2021 International Training Workshop of Waste to Energy

October 12th ~ 26th, 2021, online workshop

Program Outline

The 2021 International Training Workshop of Waste to Energy (WtE) intends to share the advanced technology and practical experience concerning Waste to Energy of China, help the participants including technicians and researchers from developing countries to improve their academic and engineering skills, and promote the international communication and cooperation. Sponsored by Department of International Cooperation, Ministry of Science and Technology of China, four training workshops of WtE have been successfully conducted since 2016, involving 91 participants from 19 developing countries. Attendees gained knowledge and information from the workshop, and they also shared their own expertise among all of themselves. A wealth of feedbacks and further collaboration have proceeded. The 2021 training workshop of WtE will be more professional and attractive, based on the previous experience.

Participants are expected to be **20 persons** from developing countries. Once the participants have completed all courses and been qualified in assessment, they will be **awarded a certificate** issued by Ministry of Science and Technology of China, which will be mailed to the participants **along with souvenirs and learning materials of the course free of charge**. Additionally, the International Consultant Committee of Waste to Energy (ICCWtE, <http://www.iccwte.org/>) will **fund outstanding participants to visit one WtE plant with full coverage of possible fees for no more than 3 days when they come to China in the future**.

The tutorials will be given online on DingTalk app by professors, senior technical experts, with contents covering theoretical knowledge and practical experience, advanced research and current applications, etc. Details are shown in the attachment. Both lectures and VR trips are included, and all are presented in English.
